Rev. Osbourne is the Founder and Executive Director of We Rise 365, Inc., a nonprofit organization whose mission is to revitalize underserved communities by empowering, educating, and equipping young men and women of color to bring transformational leadership where they live. She serves as the Executive Pastor of the Refuge Church of God under the leadership of her husband, Rev. Kevin Osbourne. Rev. Osbourne sits on the Presbytery Board of the Berean Fellowship of Churches (Columbus, OH) under the leadership of Bishop Timothy J. Clarke. She serves on the Ministries Council for Church of God Ministries (Anderson, IN), representing the Northeast region. She recently completed her term as the Church of God's representative on the Wesleyan Holiness Women Clergy Executive Board.

In 2018, she became the first woman to preach at the national convention for the Church of God Reformation Movement Barbados in its 113-year history. She and her husband have been married for twenty-five years. They currently reside in Brooklyn, New York.
